Subject: Undergrounding Project

Dear Resident:

As you may know Undergrounding of the Town's utilities has already begun on 174th Ave. East. We are all very excited about this project and the end results will be beautiful.

There are a few points we need to share with you. A three-foot by three foot (3'x3') area under your existing meter can will need to be cleared of any vegetation, cement, pavers, water softeners, etc., for the directional drilling of the utilities to your home. When your property is finished, all previous objects can be restored to their original condition. The right-of-ways (ROW) in front of your properties will also be affected during the project. For this reason we urge you to remove any lawn sprinkler systems, planters, or any other items that may be damaged by digging in the ROW. As per Town Code the Town **is not** responsible for items/structures placed in the ROW by homeowners.

If you are unable to clear these areas yourself (3x3 ft. under meter can, ROW) and would like the Town to do so for you **at your expense** please contact Town Hall at 727:397-5538.
