#### **MINUTES**

**Present Upon Roll Call:** Commissioner Wojcik, Commissioner Kapper, Commissioner Holmes, Mayor Adams; Vice Mayor Branch absent.

### Presentation – Pam Dubov, CAE, Pinellas County Property Appraiser

Mayor Adams presented Pam Dubov following an introduction of her accreditations and accomplishments. Mrs. Dubov said that the forecast for local government is not very positive, and indicated that Redington Shores may be losing taxable value at up to 13%. It is currently at 11% reduction, but may increase. Mrs. Dubov indicated there will be another estimate within 3 weeks. Mrs. Dubov also stated that residents complaining about little tax savings for doubling the homestead exemption last year was caused by an increase in the state school millage rate. With regard to foreclosure rates, the rates in Pinellas County have gone from 500 in 04/05 to 13,800 in 08/09. Mrs. Dubov cited single family sales prices for Redington Shores have decreased as well. Mrs. Dubov will contact the Town within the next 2 weeks with more information.

Public Works Hours of Operation
