WORKSHOP MEETING

BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS TOWN OF REDINGTON SHORES WEDNESDAY, MARCH 27TH, 2019 – 6:00 P.M. MINUTES

CALL TO ORDER at 6:00 p.m.

ROLL CALL- Present upon roll call were Commissioner Drumm, Commissioner Neal, Vice Mayor Kapper, Mayor Henderson, and Commissioner Robinson

OLD BUSINESS

- 1. <u>Amending Sign Code to Allow Sandwich Signs</u> Discussion amongst the commissioners is to change the ordinance to allow one sanwich board per business. This will be on a future agenda for the first reading.
- 2. Parking in Residential Areas East of Gulf Blvd. Commissioner Drumm provided a visual example using painter's tape on the floor showing the dimensions of a firetruck, ambulance and construction trucks. He depicted 20 feet across the street. Residents spoke up both in favor and against allowing street parking. Chief Swann voiced the concern that safety is the number one priority. Sgt. Kennedy stated the Indian Shores Police Department is currently using their discretion on vehicles parking on the street, such as construction workers as many times they do not have anywhere else to park. Commissioner Robinson suggested speaking to neighboring towns on how they handle their parking. Subject will be workshopped again in April.

NEW BUSINESS

1. <u>Hiring of Building Official</u> Commissioner Neal and Vice Mayor Kapper would like to seek bids from qualified candidates to hire a new building official. Mayor Henderson would like Joseph to have the opportunity to obtain his Building Official license. Commissioner Robinson would like to have outsourcing for a bit longer. Commissioner Drumm requested to compare apples to apples when it comes to the expense of an in house building official versus outsourcing for a building official.
