

**WORKSHOP MEETING  
BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS  
TOWN OF REDINGTON SHORES  
WEDNESDAY, JUNE 29, 2016 – 7:00 P.M.**

**MINUTES**

Present upon roll call: Commissioner Henderson, Commissioner Kapper, Commissioner Branch, Vice Mayor Holmes and Mayor Adams.

Ms. Maggie Cinnella, Gulf Beaches Library Director, spoke to the commission about the library's budget. Ms. Cinnella explained that due to the money reserves being exhausted they would need to increase the amount of money that they would be requesting from the five area town supporters. She stated that Redington Shore's contribution would be \$44,246.00, which is an increase of \$5,618.00 from last year's contribution. Mayor Adams stated that he wanted to know what the other supporters were going to do before the commission would decide.

**OLD BUSINESS**

Discussion – Chumming/Fishing off Shoreline

Mayor Adams read a letter from the town's attorney stating that the town could not pass an ordinance regarding blood fishing or chumming from the beaches that are owned by the State of Florida.

Discussion – Roll-up Shutters/Impact Windows at Town Hall

Commissioner Kapper reported there were three bids on the replacement of the Town Hall's windows. The commission agreed that putting in impact windows would be better than going with the roll-up shutters. Commissioner Kapper stated that he would make a recommendation at the next regular meeting.

**NEW BUSINESS**

Discussion – Supporting BIG-C Resolution 2016-02 – Waterborne Transportation throughout the barrier islands of Pinellas County

Mayor Adams said that he didn't want to pass a resolution that might cost the town money in the future. The Commission agreed that they should hold off on the resolution for now.

**MISCELLANEOUS**

Mayor Adams stated that he had been contacted by Indian Shores about the placement of their new sign. The mayor suggested that the town just wait until Indian Shores puts their sign up to decide what if anything they need to do with the town's sign.
