

**WORKSHOP MEETING

**MINUTES**

Present upon roll call: Commissioner Kapper, Commissioner Branch, and Vice Mayor Holmes. Absent Mayor Adams and Commissioner Henderson.

**OLD BUSINESS**

Discussion – FY 2015/2016 Tentative Budget

Vice Mayor Holmes stated that the new tentative budget was only changed to reflect the decrease in the millage rate from 2.0000 to 1.8000 millage. Commissioner Kapper and Commissioner Branch both agreed that the tentative budget looked okay to them.

**NEW BUSINESS**

Discussion – Amending Chapter 59, Sections (4) and (5) Abandon Property on the Beaches

Vice Mayor Holmes read the tentative changes to the ordinance regulating Abandon Property on the Beach and stated that the changes reflect what other communities on the beach have. Mr. Barry Taylor stated that Madeira Beach had just recently passed an ordinance on keeping their beach cleaned up and it would be nice if all the communities had basically the same kind of ordinances. Commissioner Branch stated that the Turtle Control people were upset about property being left on the beach. Commissioner Kapper commented that it would be nice if the people that were staying at the beach for a week could leave their Volley Ball nets up, but he understood the issues with the turtles and the town's employees trying to keep the beach clean/raked. After discussion commission decided to present the ordinance for a first reading at the next regular meeting.

**MISCELLANEOUS**

There were complaints about the trash pick-up service in town. Commissioner Kapper stated that he would contact Progressive Waste Solutions about the trash pick-up complaints. Mr. Pat Drumm also mentioned that the Deputy Town Clerk's information needed to be updated on the town's web site.
