MINUTES

Present upon roll call: Commissioner Robinson, Commissioner Neal, Vice Mayor Kapper, Mayor Henderson. Absent, Commissioner Drumm

Mayor Henderson opened the Public Hearing.

Amend and Adopt FY 2018/2019 Tentative Millage and Ad Valorem Tax

Commissioner Robinson stated the advalorem money is the major revenue collected by the town. During the budget session and meetings, the Financial Advisory Board does recommend to the Commission to keep the millage rate at 1.8000. Commissioner Robinson moved to adopt the Tentative Millage at 1.8000, seconded by Vice Mayor Kapper. Roll call: all yes.

Amend and Adopt FY 2018/2019 Tentative Budget

Commissioner Robinson highlighted some of the major revenue changes and expenses. Parking revenue has increased due to increasing the parking revenue. Commissioner Robinson pointed out both the Police and Fire expense stating both were in line. The Emergency Management line item has increased as hopefully the town will be purchasing a new LED Board. In the CIF the money for Gulf Blvd. Beautification has increased, this money spent is reimbursed to the Town from the County from the Pennies for Pinellas monies. In the Sewer Fund money has been placed to continue the sewer lining project. There being no further discussion, Commissioner Robinson moved to adopt the 2018/2019 Tentative Budget, seconded by Vice Mayor Kapper. Roll call: all yes.

Mayor Henderson closed the Public Hearing.
