OLD BUSINESS

Discussion on Sewer Maintenance Upgrades Ken Gorgan and Megan Ross gave a presentation on sewer maintenance which included how the county validates the meter and sensor each year to ensure proper billing. Mr. Gorgan and Ms. Ross explained how the sewer system of the town works and the importance of the cleaning and lining of the system.

Discussion on Placement of New LED Sign Commissioner Robinson recommended the sign be placed at Town Hall. The sign would be able to be connected thru the wifi bridge, would be unable to be hacked with our security system and would also be able to be run off of the generator in the event we are without power. The primary purpose of the sign is to inform the public in a time of emergency. Commissioners Drumm and Neal both spoke in favor of the sign being placed at Constitution Park. A resident near the park requested the commission not place the sign at the park due to the amount of homes nearby. Discussion amongst the commission ensued. The resolution was the sign will be placed in front of Town Hall.
