Present upon roll call: Commissioner Blackburn, Commissioner Neal, Vice Mayor Robinson, Mayor Henderson, and Attorney Rubenstein

Appointment of District Four Commissioner

Award Bid for Del Bello Dock Repair

Commissioner Blackburn moved to table this item, seconded by Vice Mayor Robinson. Reason being is the quotes that have been received are hugely different and there is more to fix then what was sent out in the bid. would like to re-bid this project.

Approval of Purchase for new Public Works Truck

Commissioner Blackburn reported to the Commission, that when she first came on as Commissioner, the public works staff asked for a new truck. The quote received is from the Florida Sheriff Contract. Both maintenance staff members have reviewed the quote and are happy with the purchase. Two of the trucks will be traded in. A new crane and lift are included in the quote. Commissioner Blackburn stated Chief Swann was extremely helpful in obtaining the bid. Chief Swann stated they recently purchased a similar vehicle. Commissioner Neal stated it is a fine truck, a good price and that Steve and Brad need to learn how to take care of the vehicles better than they have in the past. Commissioner Blackburn moved to amend the Capital Improvement Budget for the purchase of the truck out of the One Cent Sales Tax money in the amount of \$46,198.00, seconded by Vice Mayor Robinson.
