MINUTES

Present for roll call: Commissioner Blackburn, Commissioner Krouk, Commissioner Krajewski, Vice Mayor Robinson, and Mayor Henderson.

Approval of Updated Emergency Operations Plan

Motion to approve updated emergency operations plan made by Vice Mayor Robinson. Seconded by Commissioner Krajewski. Motion carried unanimously.

Approve Seawall Repair – 176th Terrace Drive

Commissioner Krouk stated that bid requests were sent out to four different vendors and posted on the Town website with one vendor, Gibson Marine, who proposed cost for completion of work at \$14,950. Motion by Commissioner Krouk to approve seawall repair to 176th Terrace Drive easement by Gibson Marine at a cost of \$14,950. Seconded by Commissioner Blackburn.

T. Deboy, 636 182nd Ave, asked Commissioner Krouk the length of the seawall to be repaired. She replied it was approximately 19 feet. He then expressed concern over the cost of repairs to the seawall and indicated he had his 35-foot seawall done 13 years ago for \$14,000. Mayor Henderson replied that prices had skyrocketed, stating she had a seawall replaced just a few years ago.

Motion carried unanimously.
