Call to Order

Attendees: Commissioner Jennie Blackburn (Dist 1), Marie Palena (Dist 1), Loretta Fricks (Dist 2), Susan Smith (Dist 3), Rob Francour via phone (Dist 4) and CJ Hoyt (at large).

Agenda Items:

- 1) Approve minutes for Oct 13, 2022 meeting (approved)
- 2) Old Business
 - a) Landscape Architect – the Town needs the services of a landscape architect to advise on future projects. An RFP is needed. Rob Francour will attempt to find RFP used by Indian Shores.
 - b) County beach parking lot fence replacement – Commissioner Blackburn has obtained two quotes, needs one more. Committee agreed not to recommend relocating dumpster/fencing. Also, waiting until fence and landscaping are complete before considering a mural on the dumpster fence. Committee discussed plant species along the fence: keep existing (trim) or replace. Landscape architect advice would be helpful.
 - c) Power poles along Gulf Blvd – discussed possibility of replacing Christmas decorations on the poles. Will defer until town administrator can attend a Beautification Committee meeting.
- 3) New Business
 - a) Beautification Committee Goals – review description in codes. Need to understand BC versus Parks and Rec committee responsibilities. Create short and long-term goals, such as create a single logo for

town information signage (short-term) and advice to town on code enforcement (long-term).

- b) Remove the chain link fence at the town beach lot at 177th Terrace. It serves no purpose. All members agree.

- c) Remove the faded and dilapidated wooden “Redington Shores” sign at SW corner of town hall lot. All members agree.

- d) Town bulletin boards: who puts in and removes notices (maintenance staff)?

- e) Beautification Awards: similar to Huntsville, AL program. Acknowledge property owners who maintain and/or upgrade their properties/landscaping to enhance the beauty of their community. Types of awards? Frequency? Nominating/voting? Rob will learn more about how Huntsville operates their program.
