



PROPOSED PRICING FOR SERVICES

C.A.P. Government, Inc. (CAP) a Bureau Veritas Company addresses the outsourcing of Building Department Services through a compensation model based on a "Percent of Revenue Share." This approach is both innovative and efficient, as it shifts the responsibility and risk associated with providing these services to the Consultant (CAP). Under this model, CAP is required to meet the prescribed "level of services" by adjusting the number of personnel assigned to the Town's Building Department, based on the volume of work and revenue generated.

The proposed hourly rates shown below are provided to satisfy the following scenarios:

- 1. The Town elects to use hourly services instead of percentage of revenue share
- 2. The Town elects using percentage of revenue share, but may also request "additional services"

With either of the two (2) scenarios, all work is included in the overall fees proposed.
